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#### INTRODUCTION

The Invisalign<sup>®</sup> Gallery was first published in 2010 to celebrate the success of North American clinicians who used Invisalign aligners across a broad range of orthodontic problems. From 2010 to 2014, a total of 435 treatments from 174 different doctors have been showcased in this publication. This year's edition also includes a University Challenge competition section consisting of 24 entries from 15 orthodontic residency programs in North America.

The Invisalign Gallery cases are just a small fraction of the more than 3 million patients treated with Invisalign to date, but the entire collection effectively demonstrates the growing scope of what is clinically possible. As the innovation built into Invisalign treatment continues to expand, successful treatments of Class II and Class III malocclusions, moderate to severe crowding and spacing, and open bites and deep bites are becoming more and more common in both teens and adults. Doctors are also effectively using multiple extractions, orthodontic auxiliaries such as elastics and TADs, orthognathic surgery, and complex restorative plans to achieve their desired outcomes with Invisalign, and the momentum is expected to continue as patient demand continues to grow.

All of this suggests that for many doctors, Invisalign aligners are no longer the novel, aesthetic orthodontic appliance for minor tooth movement they were once thought to be, but a viable option for even some of the most complicated malocclusions. So, to everyone who has shared their clinical experiences and expertise in the Invisalign Gallery these past five years, thank you for your



insights and for moving Invisalign treatment forward. Not only have your patients benefited from your efforts, you have inspired and challenged countless others with your success, and orthodontics as a whole has advanced significantly because of your work.

I am also very pleased to announce that Dr. Mitra Derakhshan has been selected as the new editor of the Invisalign Gallery publication. Dr. Derakhshan has successfully managed the International Invisalign Gallery since its inception, and she also practices orthodontics part-time, so clinical efficacy and treatment efficiency are both very important to her. She envisions a worldwide initiative and global digital gallery, where doctors across the entire globe can learn from each other and excel even higher. We look forward to her leadership in the next chapter of the Invisalign Gallery program.

## METHODOLOGY

The top treatments of the 2014 Invisalign Gallery were determined through double-blind online voting on a secure website developed by Align Technology, Inc. All records were displayed on the SmileScore.com website with any identifiers of the patient and treating doctor concealed. An optimization algorithm presented the treatments with the fewest votes collected first, so that the number of votes received per treatment was similar. All online voting was performed by orthodontists experienced with Invisalign treatment. Doctors with cases entered into the competition were ineligible to vote.

Close-up and comparison views were displayed by clicking on the image of interest. With the exception of cropping and image orientation, all clinical images were displayed as originally submitted by the treating doctor. All images (including radiographs) were taken and provided at the sole discretion of the treating doctor.

The treatment overview section included the patient's chief concern, the treatment time, and any auxiliaries used in conjunction with clear aligners (as reported by the treating doctor). Certain details about treatment such as the number of aligners used and the retention protocol were not displayed at the time of voting, but are reported in this publication.

Doctors rated each case on a scale of 1 (worst) to 10 (best) based on three criteria and could only vote on each case once. To prevent selective voting, skipped cases could not be revisited. Skipped cases, however, were not counted towards the average composite score calculated.

- INVISALIGN GALLERY PROGRAM DETAILS
- Entries for publication consideration (230 total) were submitted by orthodontists covered by Align Technology's North American Sales Team, and included submissions into the Invisalign Summit Shootout, along with submissions for Invisalign Gallery publication consideration only. Participants were able to enter one case per treatment category into the program, up to 4 cases total.
- Each entry was screened by an independent Clinical Review Committee. Committee members were eligible to submit entries, but could not vote on their own case(s). All reviewers were blinded to the identities of both the treating doctor and the patient. The top 85 cases from the initial screening process were published in the 2014 Invisalign Gallery and advanced as semifinalists to the online voting phase of the program.
- · Invitations for online voting were sent via email to orthodontists experienced with Invisalign treatment who were not registered to attend the 2014 Invisalign Summit. From the 5,298 email invitations sent, 308 orthodontists participated in the online voting process, with 5,749 votes received during a five-week voting window. All voting was voluntary, anonymous, and double-blind. Doctors who were semi-finalists were ineligible to vote.

Treatments were presented on the voting website at random, with a distribution optimization algorithm used to ensure that a similar number of votes were received per treatment.

• The four Invisalign Summit Shootout finalists were determined based on the highest average composite score received for the category, on a scale of 1.0 (worst) to 10.0 (best). Composite scores were calculated based on treatment difficulty (40%), results achieved (40%), and records quality (20%). The Summit Shootout winner was determined by attendees at the Invisalign Summit continuing education event (November 13-16, 2014).

Written patient and doctor consent (including parental consent where applicable) was received for all the treatments presented in this book.

• Every effort was made to accurately represent the treatment details as reported by the treating doctor. The categorization of each submission was based solely on the treating doctor's assessment of the patient's condition. With the exception of cropping/ orientation, background extensions to fit the layout, and adjustments to color and contrast, all clinical images in this publication are presented as submitted.

• Doctors who provided optional study models in addition to their submitted photographs and radiographs were compensated in the amount of up to \$300 for the doctor and up to \$50 for the patient.
